

## **Meet Tanya...**

Tanya King got involved in criminal activity as a symptom to a rough life on the streets. Eventually, she was sentenced to serve time in Stanislaus County where she faced truths about herself as a mother and how her choices affected her family. It was enough to make her realize that she never wanted to be incarcerated again and that she needed to change her life immediately.


Since LearningQuest provides High School Equivalency (HSE) education through the Jail Program, participating inmates inspired Tanya to sign up and begin working on her goals while she was there. She wanted to learn everything she could and, within two months, easily passed four tests before she was released in October, 2016. Unfortunately, she did not return to her educational goals right away. After some time Tanya faced the same issues that put her in prison, reigniting the spark for her HSE diploma. Determined to graduate, she joined the Correctional Community Partnership Program at the Learning Center in August, 2017. This time she had to persevere though failed attempts at passing the math proficiency test. With dedicated tutoring and support from classmates and instructors, Michael and Jason, she finally passed her math test and graduated four months later.

Now, Tanya has new goals of earning a truck driver's license and B.A. in Human Services. Tanya's message to students: "If I can do it - anyone can do it! Don't let any obstacles stop you or get in your way!"


